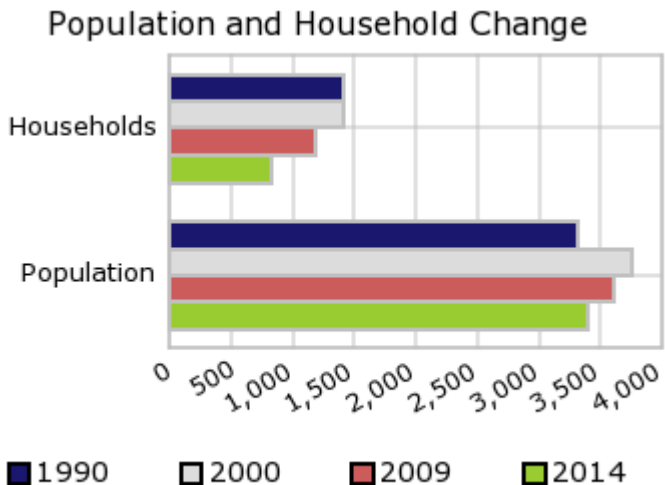

Population Demographics

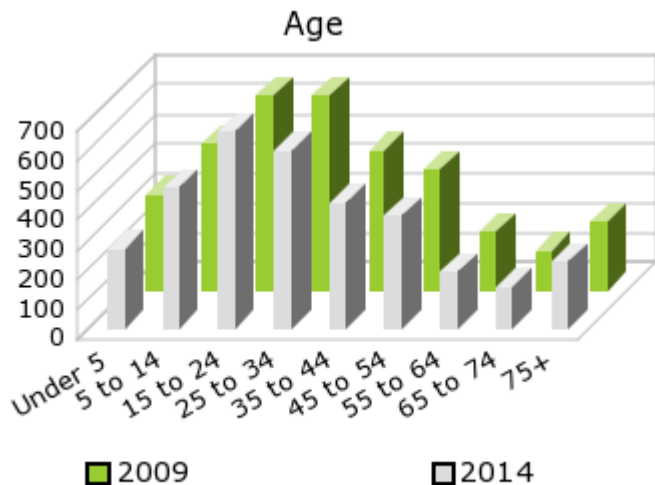
The number of households in the study area in 1990 was **1,423** and changed to **1,416** in 2000, representing a change of **-0.5%**. The household count in 2009 was **1,188** and the household projection for 2014 is **834**, a change of **-29.7%**.

The population in the study area in 1990 was **3,329** and in 2000 it was **3,762**, roughly a **13.0%** change. The population in 2009 was **3,604** and the projection for 2014 is **3,401** representing a change of **-5.6%**.

Population by Age



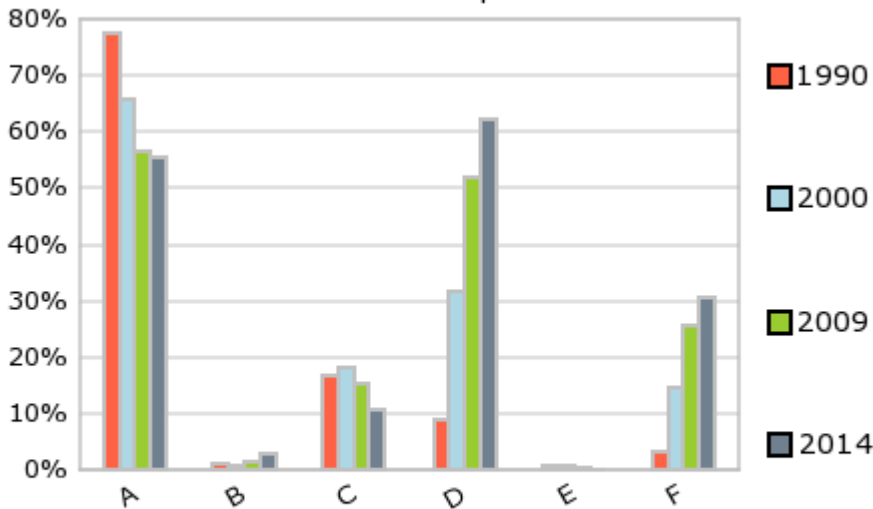
In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **32.4**, and in 2000, it was **31.3**. The median age in 2009 is **29.1** and it is predicted to change in five years to **29.2** years. In 2009, females represented **46.7%** of the population with a median age of **30.3** and males represented **53.3%** of the population with a median age of **28.2** years. In 2009, the most prominent age group in this geography is **Age 25 to 34** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **65 to 74** years.

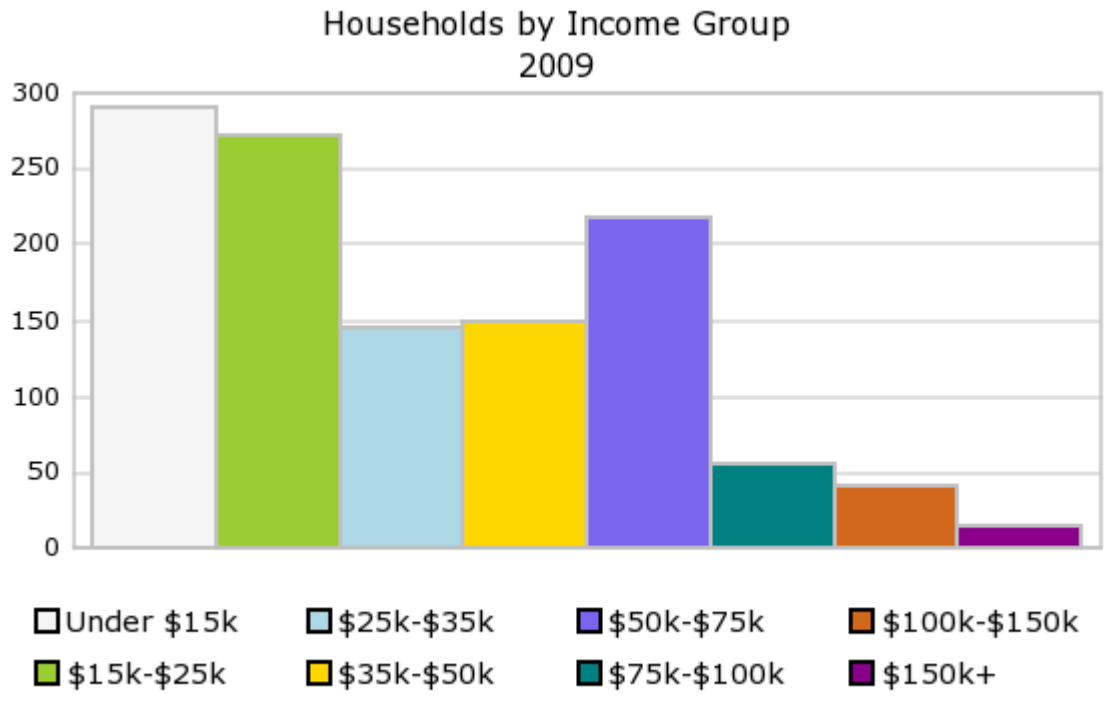
